

HAZEL DEMERY SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

Eligibility

Scholarship committee will award one (1) college scholarship per academic year for up to \$500.00. Scholarships can be applied to tuition, room, board, books, etc. Payments are made directly to the college or university of the recipient/s' choice.

To be eligible applicants must:

- Be the child, grandchild, or niece/nephew of a *Livingston County Democrat*
- Be a candidate for graduation or a graduate from Livingston Central High School, with priority given to high school seniors
- Have at least a 2.5 cumulative grade point average (on a 4.0 scale)
- Have a composite ACT score of at least an 18 or above OR a composite SAT score of at least 990, and
- Plan to attend a college or university in the fall of the year of graduation

Rules

- Committee shall select the scholarship recipient each year. The selection committee shall be responsible to review all application materials and select the scholarship recipient and a first and second alternate.
- Recipients may enter any college or university no later than the fall semester following high school graduation, unless circumstances beyond the student's control, such as illness or injury, or military service prevent enrolling at that time. In such a case, the recipient must enter college by the spring semester the following year or the scholarship award will go to the first alternate.
- Application and information must be postmarked by May 1, of the year of high school graduation or hand delivered by that date to Terry Teitloff, 788 Hillcrest, Smithland, KY 42081 or email Teitloff@vmcmail.com
- All material must be on 8.5 x 11 paper.
- Applicants must provide two (2) letters of recommendation, one from a school official and one from a professional outside the school district (non-relative).
- Applicants must submit an essay of 300 words or less about their reasons for pursuing their college choice.
- Applicants must submit an official school transcript of grades and an official record of ACT score.
- The award committee will make the final determination on all cases concerning the interpretation of these rules. All applications become the property of the scholarship committee and will not be returned.
