3 - \$1,000 Scholarships will be awarded

Only one scholarship awarded will be renewable for up to four years.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- Must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA (on a 4.0 scale) **and** a minimum 18 ACT score

RULES

- Recipient may enter any accredited college or university
- Recipient must enter college as a beginning freshman no later than the fall semester following high school graduation
- Dropping out of school, except for serious illness or injury, shall cause the recipient to lose the scholarship
- Recipient must be a full-time student each semester with a minimum of 12 hours
- Recipient is required, each semester, to furnish a transcript before additional monies are sent to the college
- Student must maintain a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5 after each semester or forfeit the scholarship
- All application materials must be postmarked by **March 31, 2021**, or hand-delivered by that date to the Livingston County Farm Bureau Attn: Scholarship Committee 507 East Adair St. or P.O. Box 159, Smithland, KY 42081
- All information regarding grades and family income will be kept confidential
- **All information must be completed**

 - Planning to major in any field
- **3rd Preference**
 - Senior – Resident of Livingston County
 - Planning to attend a four year college, two year college, or vocational school
