RULES

- Recipient may enter any accredited vocational/technical college/training/apprenticeship program
- Recipient must enter college/training/apprenticeship program no later than the fall semester following high school graduation
- Dropping out of school, except for serious illness or injury, shall cause the recipient to lose the scholarship
- Recipient is required, each semester, to furnish a transcript before additional monies are sent to the college
- All application materials must be postmarked by **March 31, 2021**, or hand-delivered by that date to the Livingston County Farm Bureau Attn: Scholarship Committee 507 East Adair St. or P.O. Box 159, Smithland, KY 42081
- All information regarding grades will be kept confidential
- **All information must be completed**

PREFERENCE OF RECIPIENTS

- **1st Preference**
 - Senior – Resident of Livingston County
 - Child of parent or guardian who is a Farm Bureau member

PLEASE ATTACH THE FOLLOWING

- A transcript of your high school grades
- At least one letter of recommendation from a school official (i.e., teacher, counselor, principal) describing your characteristics such as leadership, citizenship, and maturity.
- An essay, in 100 words or less, answering the question: **"Why I want to pursue a vocational/skilled trade career?"**
